A bill to be entitled

An act relating to late voter registration; amending s. 97.0555, F.S.; expanding the types of military personnel that are allowed to register late to vote; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 97.0555, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

97.0555 Late registration.—An individual or accompanying family member who has been discharged, or returned from a military deployment or activation, from the uniformed services or the <u>United States</u> Merchant Marine, or from employment outside the territorial limits of the United States, after the book-closing date for an election pursuant to s.

97.055 and who is otherwise qualified may register to vote in

97.055 and who is otherwise qualified may register to vote in such election until 5 p.m. on the Friday before that election in the office of the supervisor of elections. Such persons must produce sufficient documentation showing evidence of qualifying for late registration pursuant to this section.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2013.
