(b) By June 30 of each year, the corporation shall submit a report to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives comprising a comparative history of the following information for each fiscal year, beginning with the 2008-2009 fiscal year: the amount of funds appropriated, the number of scholarships awarded, the number of scholarship recipients currently fulfilling their Florida teaching commitment, the number of scholarship recipients who have completed their Florida teaching commitment, the number of scholarship recipients who have defaulted on the scholarship, the balance of the unpaid scholarship funds, and the total amount of scholarship funds that have been repaid.
