A bill to be entitled

An act relating to discrimination; amending s. 760.10, F.S.; prohibiting employment discrimination on the basis of pregnancy, childbirth, or related medical conditions; providing an exception for certain benefits; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (c) is added to subsection (1) of section 760.10, Florida Statutes, to read:

760.10 Unlawful employment practices.-

- (1) It is an unlawful employment practice for an employer:
- individual, or otherwise to discriminate against any individual with respect to compensation, terms, conditions, or privileges of employment, because of or on the basis of pregnancy, childbirth, or related medical conditions. A woman affected by pregnancy, childbirth, or related medical conditions shall be treated the same for all employment-related purposes, including receipt of benefits under fringe benefit programs, as other persons not so affected but similar in their ability or inability to work. This paragraph shall not require an employer to pay for health insurance benefits for abortion.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2013.
