28 (c) A farming or ranching structure, as part of an 29 operation that employs fewer than 25 full-time equivalent workers, calculated as cumulative hours worked divided by 40 30 31 hours, which is not used by the public for direct sales or as an educational outreach facility, is exempt from the Florida Fire 32 33 Prevention Code, including the national codes and Life Safety Code incorporated by reference.
