- (1) "Agritourism activity" means any agricultural related activity consistent with a bona fide carried out on a farm, or ranch or in a working forest that allows members of the general public, for recreational, entertainment, or educational purposes, to view or enjoy rural activities, including farming, ranching, historical, cultural, or harvest-your-own, or nature-based activities and attractions. An agritourism activity does not include the construction of new or additional structures or facilities intended primarily to house, shelter, transport, or otherwise accommodate members of the general public. An activity is an agritourism activity whether or not the participant paid to participate in the activity.
- (2) "Agritourism <u>operator professional</u>" means any person who is engaged in the business of providing one or more agritourism activities, whether or not for compensation.

In any action for damages against an agritourism operator, his or her employer or employee, and the owner of the underlying land on which the agritourism occurs for agritourism activity, the agritourism operator, his or her employer or employee, and the owner of the underlying land on which the agritourism occurs must plead the affirmative defense of assumption of the risk of agritourism activity by the participant.

- (2) In the event of the injury or death of, or damage or loss to, an agritourism participant, subsection (1) does not prevent or limit the liability of an agritourism operator or his or her employer or employee or the owner of the underlying land on which the agritourism occurs if he or she:
- (a) Commits an act or omission that constitutes negligence or willful or wanton disregard for the safety of the participant, and that act or omission proximately causes injury, damage, or death to the participant;
- (b) Has actual knowledge of, or reasonably should have known of, a dangerous condition on the land or in the facilities or with the equipment used in the activity or the dangerous propensity of a particular animal used in the activity, and does not make the danger known to the participant and the danger
