Section 2. Section 943.1726, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

943.1726 Continued employment training relating to diabetic emergencies. -- The department shall establish an on-line continued employment training component relating to diabetic emergencies. Instruction shall include, but need not be limited to, recognition of symptoms of such an emergency, distinguishing such an emergency from alcohol intoxication or drug overdose, and appropriate first aid for such an emergency. Completion of the training component may count toward the 40 hours of instruction for continued employment or appointment as a law
