(b) The department shall create a separate list of all special districts declared inactive as provided in this section and shall maintain each such district on this inactive list until the district is declared by the department as resuming active status, the district is merged as provided in ss. 189.071 or 189.074, or the district is dissolved as provided in ss. 189.071 or 189.072.

Section 3. Subsections (2) and (3) of section 189.071, Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

 $189.071\,$ Merger or dissolution of a dependent special district.—

- (2) The merger or dissolution of an active dependent special district created and operating pursuant to a special act may be effectuated only by further act of the Legislature unless otherwise provided by general law.
- (3) A dependent special district that meets any criteria for being declared inactive, or that has already been declared inactive, pursuant to s. 189.062 may be dissolved or merged by special act without a referendum.

Section 4. Subsection (3) of section 189.072, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

189.072 Dissolution of an independent special district.-

(3) INACTIVE INDEPENDENT SPECIAL DISTRICTS.—An independent special district that meets any criteria for being declared inactive, or that has already been declared inactive, pursuant to s. 189.062 may be dissolved by special act without a

referendum. If an inactive independent special district was created by a county or municipality through a referendum, the county or municipality that created the district may dissolve the district after publishing notice as described in s. 189.062.
