\$10.0 billion in Transportation Investments

- \$9.1 billion in Transportation Improvements
 - \$3.8 billion for Highway Construction
 - \$634 million to Resurface/Reconstruct roads
 - \$245 million for Bridge Repair and Replacement
 - \$142 million for Seaport Infrastructure Improvements
 - \$359 million for Aviation Improvements
 - \$166 million for safety improvements

- a) *Preservation.*--Protecting the state's transportation infrastructure investment. Preservation includes:
- 1. Ensuring that 80% of the pavement on the State Highway System meets department standards;
- 2. Ensuring that 90% of departmentmaintained bridges meet department standards; and
- 3. Ensuring that the department achieves 100% of the acceptable maintenance standard on the state highway system.



FIVE-YEAR WORK PROGRAM FY 2016-20


TOTAL BY FUNDING SOURCES

FIVE-YEAR WORK PROGRAM FY 2016-20 Total By Major Activity



Budget Amounts by Type:




TOTAL FY 2015-16 BUDGET \$10.1B
