Remove everything after the enacting clause and insert:

Section 1. Subsection (4) of section 196.081, Florida Statutes, is amended, subsections (5) and (6) are renumbered as subsections (6) and (7), respectively, and a new subsection (5) is added to that section to read:

196.081 Exemption for certain <u>total and</u> permanently and totally disabled veterans and for surviving spouses of veterans; exemption for surviving spouses of first responders who die in the line of duty.-

(4) Any real estate that is owned and used as a homestead
by the surviving spouse of a <u>servicemember</u> veteran who died from
service-connected causes while on active duty as a member of the

Bill No. HB 611 (2016)

18 United States Armed Forces and for whom a letter from the United 19 States Government or United States Department of Veterans 20 Affairs or its predecessor has been issued certifying that the servicemember veteran who died from service-connected causes 21 22 while on active duty is exempt from taxation if the veteran was 23 a permanent resident of this state on January 1 of the year in 24 which the veteran died. 25 (5) (a) The unremarried surviving spouse of a veteran who 26 was honorably discharged with a service-connected total and 27 permanent disability is entitled to the same exemption that 28 would otherwise be granted to a surviving spouse as described in subsections (1)-(3), if the veteran, at the time of death, owned 29 30 property in another state in the United States and used it in a manner that would have qualified for homestead exemption under 31 s. 196.031 if the property was located in this state on January 32 1 of the year the veteran died. To qualify for the exemption 33 34 under this subsection, the unremarried surviving spouse, subsequent to the death of the veteran, must hold the legal or 35 beneficial title to homestead property in this state and 36 37 permanently reside thereon as specified in s. 196.031 as of January 1 of the tax year for which the exemption is being 38 39 claimed. (b) The surviving spouse must provide documentation as set 40 forth in subsection (2) to the property appraiser in the county 41 in which the property is located. 42 (c) The tax exemption provided by this subsection: 43 903273 - Amendment 1 Strike All.docx
