31 bonds with a term not exceeding 20 years and not exceeding the
32 useful life of the asset being financed. Florida College System
33 institutions shall use the services of the Division of Bond
34 Finance of the State Board of Administration to issue any
35 revenue bonds authorized by this subsection. Any such bonds
36 issued by the Division of Bond Finance shall be in compliance
37 with the provisions of the State Bond Act. Bonds issued pursuant
38 to the State Bond Act may be validated in the manner established
39 in chapter 75. The complaint for such validation shall be filed
40 in the circuit court of the county where the seat of state
41 government is situated, the notice required to be published by
42 s. 75.06 shall be published only in the county where the
43 complaint is filed, and the complaint and order of the circuit

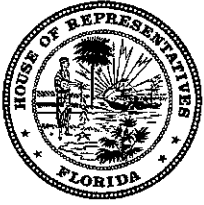
