A bill to be entitled
An act relating to state veterans' nursing homes; creating s. 296.42, F.S.; requiring the Department of Veterans' Affairs to contract for a study to determine the need for an additional state veterans' nursing home and the most appropriate county for the home; requiring the department to deliver the study to the Governor, President of the Senate, and Speaker of the House of Representatives by a certain date; establishing criteria for ranking each county according to need; requiring the department to use the study to select new nursing home sites; requiring the department to use a previous study to select new nursing home sites prior to a certain date; providing for expiration of the section on July 1, 2020, unless reviewed and saved by repeal by the Legislature prior to that date; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 296.42, Florida Statutes, is created to read:
296.42 Site selection process for state veterans' nursing
homes.--
(1) The department shall contract for a study to determine the need for a new state veterans' nursing home and the most

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appropriate county based on the greatest level of need for construction of the nursing home. The department shall deliver the study to the Governor, the President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives by November 1, 2015.
(2) The study shall use the following criteria to rank each county according to need:
(a) The distance from the geographic center of the county to the nearest existing state veterans' nursing home;
(b) The number of veterans aged 65 years or older living in the county;
(c) The presence of an existing federal Veterans' Health Administration medical center or outpatient clinic in the county;
(d) Elements of emergency health care in the county, as determined by:

1. The number of general hospitals;
2. The number of emergency room holding beds per hospital; and
3. The number of in-house physicians per hospital on staff in the emergency room 24 hours per day.
(e) The number of existing community nursing home beds per thousand elderly male residents of the county;
(f) The presence of an accredited education institution offering health care programs in the county; and
(g) The county poverty rate.
(3) The department shall use the study ranking to select

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53 each new state veterans' nursing home site authorized prior to July 1, 2020, subject to approval by the Governor and Cabinet. For each new nursing home, the department shall select the highest-ranked county in the study which does not have a veterans' nursing home. If the highest ranked county cannot serve as the site, the department shall select the next highest ranked county. Prior to November 1, 2015, the department shall use the 2014 Site Selection Study to select a county for any new state veterans' nursing home.
(4) This section shall expire on July 1, 2020, unless reviewed and saved from repeal through reenactment by the Legislature before that date.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2015.

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
