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(1) All fully autonomous vehicles must have uninsured and underinsured vehicle coverage as required by s. 627.727, personal injury protection coverage as provided by s. 627.736,

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and liability coverage in the amount of at least \$500,000 for

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combined bodily injury liability and property damage liability

(7) TRANSPORTATION NETWORK COMPANY AND THE DRIVER

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#### INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS .-

- (a) Beginning July 1, 2017, a TNC driver or a TNC on behalf of the TNC driver shall maintain primary automobile insurance that:
- Recognizes that the TNC driver is a TNC driver or otherwise uses a vehicle to transport riders for compensation;
   and
- Covers the TNC driver while the TNC driver is logged on to the digital network of the TNC or while the TNC driver is engaged in a prearranged ride.
- (b) The following automobile insurance requirements apply while a participating TNC driver is logged on to the digital network but is not engaged in a prearranged ride:
  - 1. Automobile insurance that provides:
- a. A primary automobile liability coverage of at least \$50,000 for death and bodily injury per person, \$100,000 for death and bodily injury per incident, and \$25,000 for property damage;
- b. Personal injury protection benefits that meet the minimum coverage amounts required under ss. 627.730-627.7405; and
- c. Uninsured and underinsured vehicle coverage as required by s. 627.727.
- 2. The coverage requirements of this paragraph may be satisfied by any of the following:

- (e)(d) If the TNC driver's insurance under paragraph (b) or paragraph (c) has lapsed or does not provide the required coverage, the insurance maintained by the TNC must provide the coverage required under this subsection, beginning with the first dollar of a claim, and have the duty to defend such claim.
- (f) (e) Coverage under an automobile insurance policy maintained by the TNC must not be dependent on a personal automobile insurer first denying a claim, and a personal automobile insurance policy is not required to first deny a claim.
- (g) (f) Insurance required under this subsection must be provided by an insurer authorized to do business in this state which is a member of the Florida Insurance Guaranty Association or an eligible surplus lines insurer that has a superior, excellent, exceptional, or equivalent financial strength rating by a rating agency acceptable to the Office of Insurance Regulation of the Financial Services Commission.
- (h) (g) Insurance satisfying the requirements under this subsection is deemed to satisfy the financial responsibility requirement for a motor vehicle under chapter 324 and the security required under s. 627.733 for any period when the TNC

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driver is logged onto the digital network or engaged in a prearranged ride.

(i) (h) A TNC driver shall carry proof of coverage satisfying paragraphs (b) and (c) with him or her at all times during his or her use of a TNC vehicle in connection with a digital network. In the event of an accident, a TNC driver shall provide this insurance coverage information to any party directly involved in the accident or the party's designated representative, automobile insurers, and investigating police officers. Proof of financial responsibility may be presented through an electronic device, such as a digital phone application, under s. 316.646. Upon request, a TNC driver shall also disclose to any party directly involved in the accident or the party's designated representative, automobile insurers, and investigating police officers whether he or she was logged on to a digital network or was engaged in a prearranged ride at the time of the accident.

(j)(i) If a TNC's insurer makes a payment for a claim covered under comprehensive coverage or collision coverage, the TNC shall cause its insurer to issue the payment directly to the business repairing the vehicle or jointly to the owner of the vehicle and the primary lienholder on the covered vehicle.

Remove everything after the enacting clause and insert:

Section 1. Subsection (2) of section 316.003, Florida

Statutes, is amended to read:

316.003 Definitions.—The following words and phrases, when used in this chapter, shall have the meanings respectively ascribed to them in this section, except where the context otherwise requires:

(2) AUTOMATED DRIVING SYSTEM.—The hardware and software that are collectively capable of performing the entire dynamic driving task of an autonomous vehicle on a sustained basis, regardless of whether it is limited to a specific operational

design domain, as specified in SAE International Standard J3016
(Revised September 2016). The term "autonomous vehicle" means
AUTONOMOUS VEHICLE. any vehicle equipped with an automated
driving system designed to function at a level of driving
automation of Level 3, 4, or 5, as specified in SAE
International Standard J3016 (Revised September 2016). The term
"fully autonomous vehicle" means a vehicle equipped with an
automated driving system designed to function at a level of
driving automation of Level 4 or 5, as specified in SAE
International Standard J3016 (Revised September 2016) autonomous
technology. The term "autonomous technology" means technology
installed on a motor vehicle that has the capability to drive
the vehicle on which the technology is installed without the
active control or monitoring by a human operator. The term
excludes a motor vehicle enabled with active safety systems or
driver assistance systems, including, without limitation, a
system to provide electronic blind spot assistance, crash
avoidance, emergency braking, parking assistance, adaptive
cruise control, lane keep assistance, lane departure warning, or
traffic jam and queuing assistant, unless any such system alone
or in combination with other systems enables the vehicle on
which the technology is installed to drive without active
control or monitoring by a human operator.
