At the end of existing proviso language, following Specific Appropriation 422, INSERT:

From the funds in Specific Appropriation 422, \$126,422 from the General Revenue Fund and \$1,817,426 from the Administrative Trust Fund shall be held in reserve. The department is authorized to submit budget amendments for the release of these funds pursuant to the provisions of chapter 216, Florida Statutes. Release shall be contingent upon implementation of Art. IX Sec. 29, Fla. Const., and ss. 381.986, 381.987 and 381.988, Florida Statutes, solely and exclusively by adopting all

rules required by statute and any other rules necessary to implement this constitutional provision, and adopting all such rules solely and exclusively pursuant to chapter 120, Florida Statutes.

424 Expenses

At the end of existing proviso language, following Specific Appropriation 424, INSERT:

From the funds in Specific Appropriation 424, \$108,172 from the General Revenue Fund and \$281,961 from the Administrative Trust Fund shall be held in reserve. The department is authorized to submit budget amendments for the release of these funds pursuant to the provisions of chapter 216, Florida Statutes. Release shall be contingent upon implementation of Art. IX Sec. 29, Fla. Const., and ss. 381.986, 381.987 and 381.988, Florida Statutes, solely and exclusively by adopting all rules required by statute and any other rules necessary to implement this constitutional provision, and adopting all such rules solely and exclusively pursuant to chapter 120, Florida Statutes.

Line item amendments are accepted as part of the amendatory process. However, due to the necessity of using computerized systems this may entail a different placement within a budget entity or the renumbering of the specific appropriation items.
