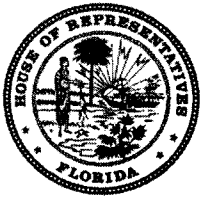

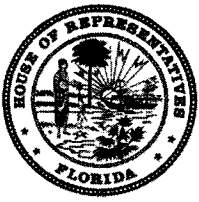

Budget Request \$1.7M Recurring

The UF Lastinger Center is requesting a \$1.7M recurring appropriation for programmatic development and statewide implementation of educational innovations. The Center received this funding for eight years (2009-2016) and has developed high-impact educational programs in partnership with the Florida Legislature and Governor Scott that align with statewide public policy, particularly related to STEM, workforce preparedness, early childhood education, and literacy.

OBJECTIVES

The Lastinger Center is an education innovation hub that researches, develops, and scales systems that improve teaching and learning across Florida.

This appropriation will enable the Lastinger Center to:

- Fulfill mandate from HB 7069 to develop and implement a statewide literacy professional development system with Just Read! Florida
- Fulfill mandate from HB 7069 to lead a commission on early learning assessments in Florida
- Expand its STEM and workforce preparedness programs through the Algebra Nation system
- Offer competency-based training for 55,000 early childhood educators across Florida through Early Learning Florida
- Develop other innovations that align with state educational and workforce development priorities
