561.57 Deliveries by licensees.-

(1) Vendors shall be permitted to make deliveries away from their places of business of sales actually made at the licensed place of business; provided, telephone, electronic, or mail orders received at vendor's licensed place of business shall be construed as a sale actually made at the vendor's licensed place of business. <u>Deliveries made by a vendor away</u> from his or her place of business may be made in vehicles that
