29 displayed on a device in or connected to the subscriber's

31 (9) (a) The department shall investigate any complaints
32 received concerning violations of this section. If, after
33 investigating a complaint, the department finds that there has
34 been a violation of this section, the department or the
35 Department of Legal Affairs may bring an action to impose a
36 civil penalty and to seek other relief, including injunctive
37 relief, as the court deems appropriate against the telephone
38 solicitor. The civil penalty shall be in the Class IV ~~III~~
39 category pursuant to s. 570.971 for each violation and shall be
40 deposited in the General Inspection Trust Fund if the action or
41 proceeding was brought by the department, or the Legal Affairs

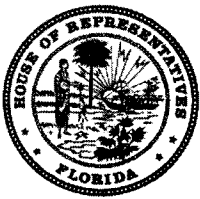

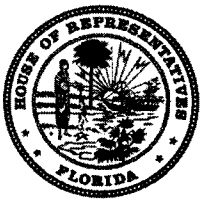

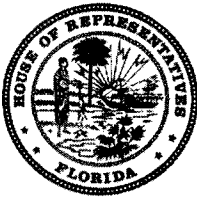
