It shall be unlawful for any person who makes a 8 (C) telephonic sales call or causes a telephonic sales call to be 9 made to fail to transmit or cause not to be transmitted the 10 telephone number and, when made available by the telephone 11 solicitor's carrier, the name of the telephone solicitor to any 12 caller identification service in use by a recipient of a 13 telephonic sales call. If a telephone number is made available through 19 20 a caller identification service as a result of a telephone sales call, that telephone number must be capable of receiving phone 21 22 calls and must connect the original call recipient, upon calling 23 such number, to the telephone solicitor or to the seller on 24 behalf of which a telephonic sales call was placed. For purposes 25 of this section, the term "caller identification service" means 26 a service that allows a telephone subscriber to have the telephone number and, where available, the name of the calling 27 28 party transmitted contemporaneously with the telephone call and 29 displayed on a device in or connected to the subscriber's 30 telephone.

31 The department shall investigate any complaints (9)(a) 32 received concerning violations of this section. If, after investigating a complaint, the department finds that there has 33 34 been a violation of this section, the department or the 35 Department of Legal Affairs may bring an action to impose a civil penalty and to seek other relief, including injunctive 36 37 relief, as the court deems appropriate against the telephone 38 solicitor. 42 Revolving Trust Fund if the action or proceeding was brought by 43 the Department of Legal Affairs. This civil penalty may be 44 recovered in any action brought under this part by the 45 department, or the department may terminate any investigation or 46 action upon agreement by the person to pay a stipulated civil 47 penalty. The department or the court may waive any civil penalty 48 if the person has previously made full restitution or reimbursement or has paid actual damages to the consumers who 49 have been injured by the violation. 50

51 The department may, as an alternative to the civil (b) penalties provided in paragraph (a), impose an administrative 52 fine in the Class III + category pursuant to s. 570.971 for each 53 act or omission that constitutes a violation of this section. An 54 55 administrative proceeding that could result in the entry of an order imposing an administrative penalty must be conducted 56 57 pursuant to chapter 120.
