HB 1397 Comments

Amendment 2 (A2) states that “Nothing in this section shall limit the legislature from **enacting laws consistent with** this section.” The legislature, therefore, cannot pass a constitutional law unless it is consistent with the language in A2. The following main issues within HB 1397 are not consistent with A2:

- **No new business registrations.** Presently, HB 1397 only grandfathers in the existing Low-THC license winners and guarantees them 150,000 patients before any additional competition is allowed to participate. Then only the “next in line” applicants who lost nearly two years ago are allowed to participate until a patient count of 200,000 is reached. This artificial patient trigger count creates a new **certificate of need** type license and goes against House stated principles of **government picking winners/losers** and the **free-market principles**, which are designed to drive prices down and increase quality/selection/innovation. Why should companies who did not apply two years ago for Low-THC only, with proven track records of creating new routes of administration and quality control, be locked out of participating in Florida?
- **Physician – Patient Relationship.** Presently, HB 1397 restricts the physician-patient relationship in several ways:
 - Requires the physician to create a prescription, not a simple certification of eligibility.
 - Maintains the existing 90 day pre-existing relationship (unless terminal).
 - Requires re-certification at least every 90 days.
 - Requires all non-specifically-listed conditions be justified and documented to the Board of Medicine for every patient.
 - Requires physician CME course as a pre-requisite for a physician certification.

Other major issues in HB 1397:

- Cannot require permanent residency.
- Cannot ban smoking, edibles and/or vaping (vaping allowed for terminal)

Good things in HB 1397:

- Emergency rules and a SERC exemption for DOH rules.
- Language for possession on school grounds.
- 30 day price average for patients benefit.
- Allowing local control of retail.

**ARIZONA CATHOLIC CONFERENCE BISHOPS' STATEMENT OPPOSING THE
LEGALIZATION OF RECREATIONAL MARIJUANA**

June 30, 2016

The Bishops of the Arizona Catholic Conference oppose the campaign to legalize the recreational use of marijuana in Arizona because it is harmful to both children and families in Arizona.

Legalizing the recreational use of marijuana sends a message to children and young people that drug use is socially and morally acceptable. As people of faith, we must speak out against this effort and the damaging effects its passage would have on the children and families of Arizona.

Studies have shown that adolescents who use marijuana have significant differences in brain structure and cognitive functioning compared to those who do not use marijuana and experience up to an eight-point drop in IQ. Furthermore, based on what happened in just two years after Colorado legalized marijuana, it is estimated that if Arizona passes this measure, tens of thousands of additional 8th graders here will smoke marijuana for the first time.

Marijuana-related traffic accidents and other problems are also likely to dramatically increase if recreational marijuana use is legalized. In Colorado for example, marijuana-related traffic deaths dramatically increased after recreational marijuana was legalized. Additionally, Colorado witnessed similar dramatic increases in hospitalizations and emergency room visits related to marijuana usage after recreational use was legalized.

In states that have legalized marijuana, there has also been an increase in the use of harder drugs like cocaine and heroin since marijuana was legalized, which only further increased societal costs.

For the reasons mentioned above, and others, it is anticipated that legalizing the recreational use of marijuana in Arizona will lead to more abuse by teens, more emergency room visits, more traffic deaths, and more societal costs. Accordingly, due to the detrimental effect it would have on children, families, and all of society, we strongly oppose this dangerous proposal.

HB 1397 Analysis and Review

Executive Summary: House Bill 1397 is overreaching in its regulation of the Medical Marijuana Industry and the lives of patients and their caregivers. This bill infringes upon basic liberties and the rights to make the best medical decisions for patients.

Shortcomings:

1. This bill limits the methods of ingestion for patients by banning edibles and smoked flowers. Methods of ingestion vary from patient to patient depending on their medical condition and ability consume cannabis in its variety of forms. Some patients find it necessary to consume cannabis in the form of edibles containing cannabinoid extracts due their inability to vape oils or smoke flowers. Certain digestive disorders and stomach cancers may also require edible ingestion. Other patients find smoking cannabis flowers beneficial due to the productive cough it can induce. All in all, no legislation should limit options of sick patients. The method of ingestion should be between a patient and their recommending physician.
2. This bill limits where cannabis can be utilized. While it would seem logical that no one wants to see people consuming cannabis on a bus or in an office, debilitating medical conditions such as epilepsy and other disorders can strike without warning and regard for a person's surroundings. Patients must be given an emergency provision to consume cannabis when these episodic, life-threatening incidents occur.
3. This bill requires physicians to take a certification course. This provision seems more about generating revenue for those testing entities than actually protecting patients from physicians who do not know what they are doing. Physicians can recommend and prescribe much more dangerous and deadlier drugs than cannabis fresh out of school. These unnecessary requirements will burden patients in seeking a new physician that is certified rather than their physicians most familiar with their condition.

4. This bill requires unnecessary level two background checks of caregivers. This requirement also precludes those with felony convictions, not taking into account that cannabis prohibition may have resulted in said conviction and should not be a disqualifier in caring for sick relative.
5. In addition to unnecessary background requirements, this bill does not allow caregivers to have gainful employment in the medical marijuana industry. With the wealth and knowledge gained by caring for a loved one, caregivers are ideal candidates to work in the industry and provide helpful knowledge to consumers. This restriction is unnecessary.
6. The additional licensing of medical cannabis growers and treatment centers in Florida is tied to patient registration thresholds. It should be noted that adequate servicing of patients is typically a maximum of one thousand patients per treatment center among industry standards. Therefore these numbers must be re-adjusted with this in mind.

Additional Recommendations:

1. Current law requires patients to wait 90 days from the time of their first visit to the time a physician can recommend cannabis to them with an additional 45 day waiting period before being able to obtain cannabis from a MMTC. This is a burdensome requirement on people already sick and suffering. It is recommended clarification be amended into this bill and these requirements removed.
2. Any Medical Cannabis Patient registry must be fully HIPAA compliant and outside entities should not have access to this database.
3. Sick patients must be protected from dangerous pesticides and chemicals used by many nurseryman. Banning pesticides and additional chemicals which can harm patients must be part of any regulation.
4. Truth in product components must be part of any effective treatment plan and therefore strict laboratory testing requirements cannabinoid levels must conducted and utilized in product information and labeling.
5. Mold, bacteria, and other pathogens are a risk when growers do not properly attend their plants in the cultivation process. Strict testing for these dangers to patients must also be part of any industry regulation.
