Remove lines 558-565 and insert:

6 (1)(a) Except as provided in subsections (3), (4), and  
 7 (5), a person who knowingly and willfully transports into this  
 8 state an individual whom ~~who~~ the person knows, or reasonably  
 9 should know, has entered ~~is illegally entering~~ the United States  
 10 in violation of law and has not been inspected by the Federal  
 11 Government since his or her unlawful entry from another country  
 12 commits a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in  
 13 s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084.

14 (b) This subsection does not apply to an unaccompanied  
 15 alien child as defined in 6 U.S.C. s. 279(g)(2) or to a person  
 16 who is a naturalized United States citizen; who is a lawful

17 permanent resident status of this state; who has a pending  
18 application under the Cuban Adjustment Act or under any other  
19 pending adjustment of status application; who is on parole by  
20 the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services or by the  
21 United States Customs and Border Protection; who has a federal T  
22 visa, a federal U visa, or protection under the federal Violence  
23 Against Women Act; or who has a pending or approved  
24 certification under the federal T visa, federal U Visa, or  
25 Violence Against Women Act.
