(C) 29 "Telephone numbers" has the same meaning as provided 30 in s. 119.071(4)(d). The home addresses, telephone numbers, and dates of 31 (2) 32 birth, places of employment, and photographs of current or former public guardians and employees with fiduciary 33 34 responsibility; photographs of former public guardians and employees with fiduciary responsibility; the names, home 35 addresses, telephone numbers, and dates of birth, and places of 36 employment of the spouses and children of current or former 37 public guardians or employees with fiduciary responsibility, who 38 39 are not themselves current or former public guardians or 40 employees with fiduciary responsibility such persons; and the 41 names and locations of schools and day care facilities attended by the children of such persons are exempt from s. 119.07(1) and 42 43 s. 24(a), Art. As used in this section, the term "employee with fiduciary responsibility" means 44 45 an employee of a public guardian who has the ability to direct 46 any transactions of a ward's funds, assets, or property; who 47 under the supervision of the quardian, manages the care of the 48 ward; or who makes any health care decision, as defined in s. 49 765.101, on behalf of the ward. This exemption applies to information held by an agency before, on, or after July 1, 2018. 50

An agency that is the custodian of the information specified in 51 52 this section shall maintain the exempt status of that 53 information only if the current or former public guardians and 54 employees with fiduciary responsibility submit to the custodial 55 agency a written request for maintenance of the exemption. This 56 section is subject to the Open Government Sunset Review Act in 57 accordance with s. 119.15 and shall stand repealed on October 2, 58 2023, unless reviewed and saved from repeal through reenactment 59 by the Legislature. 60

Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2023.
