 11 Section 1. Paragraph (o) of subsection (2) of section
 12 119.071, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

13 119.071 General exemptions from inspection or copying of
 14 public records.—

15 (2) AGENCY INVESTIGATIONS.—

16 (o) The address of a victim of an incident of mass
 17 violence is exempt from s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of the
 18 State Constitution. For purposes of this paragraph, the term
 19 "incident of mass violence" means an incident in which four or
 20 more people, not including the perpetrator, are severely injured
 21 or killed by an intentional and indiscriminate act of violence
 22 of another. For purposes of this paragraph, the term "victim"
 23 means a person killed or injured during an incident of mass
 24 violence, not including the perpetrator. ~~This paragraph is~~
