SUMMARY ANALYSIS

During the 2022 Regular Legislative Session, the Legislature passed CS/SB 1048 (ch. 2022-16, L.O.F.), which among other things, directed the Division of Law Revision and Information of the Office of Legislative Services to prepare a reviser’s bill to change the term “Next Generation Sunshine State Standards” in Florida Statutes with the phrase “state academic standards.”

The bill makes the conforming changes directed by CS/SB 1048.

The bill has no fiscal impact.

Except as otherwise provided, the bill takes effect on the 60th day after adjournment sine die.

Section 10, ch. 2022-16, L.O.F., directed the Division of Law Revision to prepare a reviser's bill to replace references to "Next Generation Sunshine State Standards" in Florida Statutes with the phrase "state academic standards." The bill makes these conforming changes, pursuant to the directive.
