Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 1006.05, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

1006.05 Mental health coordinated system of care.—
(1) Pursuant to s. 394.491 and to further promote the effective implementation of a coordinated system of care pursuant to ss. 394.4573 and 394.495, each school district that provides mental health assessment, diagnosis, intervention, treatment, and recovery services to students diagnosed with one or more mental health or any co-occurring substance use disorder and students at high risk of such diagnoses shall be guided by and adhere to the guiding principles of the mental health treatment and support system as provided under s. 394.491.

(2)(a) Pursuant to s. 394.494, each school district shall
