- (3) Participating schools shall ensure that students are provided appropriate notice as to the availability and location of the menstrual hygiene products.
- (4) School districts are encouraged to partner with nonprofit organizations, nongovernmental organizations, businesses, and other organizations to assist in supplying and maintaining such menstrual hygiene products.
 - Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2023.
