Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subsection (6) of section
 1002.45, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

1002.45 Virtual instruction programs.—

(6) VIRTUAL INSTRUCTION PROGRAM AND VIRTUAL CHARTER SCHOOL
 FUNDING.—

(b) Students enrolled in a virtual instruction program
 shall be funded in the Florida Education Finance Program as
 provided in the General Appropriations Act. The calculation to

26 determine the amount of funds for each student through the
 27 Florida Education Finance Program shall include the sum of the
 28 base Florida Education Finance Program pursuant to s.
 29 1011.62(1)(t) ~~s. 1011.62(1)(s)~~ and all categorical programs
 30 except for the categorical programs established pursuant to ss.
 31 1011.62(1)(f), (7), and (13); 1011.68; 1011.685; and 1012.71.
 32 Students residing outside of the school district reporting the
 33 full-time equivalent virtual student shall be funded from state

39 (6) AWARD OF A STANDARD HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA.—

40 (c) A student who earns the required 24 credits, or the
 41 required 18 credits under s. 1002.3105(5), but fails to pass the
 42 assessments required under s. 1008.22(3) or achieve a 2.0 GPA
 43 shall be awarded a certificate of completion in a form
 44 prescribed by the State Board of Education. However, a student
 45 who is otherwise entitled to a certificate of completion may
 46 elect to remain in high school either as a full-time student or
 47 a part-time student for up to 1 additional year and receive
 48 special instruction designed to remedy his or her identified
 49 deficiencies.

50 1. The school district must notify each student entitled

51 to a certificate of completion and his or her parents, in
 52 writing, of the option for the student to remain in high school
 53 for up to 1 additional year to receive special instruction to
 54 remedy his or her identified deficiencies and graduate with a
 55 standard high school diploma. The notification must include the
 56 contact information of a certified school counselor who can
 57 advise the student and his or her parents on this option.

58 2. If the student elects to be awarded a certificate of
 59 completion and declines the additional year of instruction, the
 60 student's certified school counselor or other school personnel
 61 shall inform the student of opportunities to continue his or her
 62 education through eligible postsecondary, workforce, and adult
 63 education programs.

64 3. The State Board of Education shall adopt rules to

76 (1) COMPUTATION OF THE BASIC AMOUNT TO BE INCLUDED FOR
 77 OPERATION.—The following procedure shall be followed in
 78 determining the annual allocation to each district for
 79 operation:

80 (q) Calculation of additional full-time equivalent
 81 membership based on the award of standard high school diplomas
 82 to students eligible for a certificate of completion.—A value of
 83 0.5 full-time equivalent student membership shall be calculated
 84 for each student who is entitled to a certificate of completion
 85 who elects to remain in high school for up to 1 additional year
 86 pursuant to s. 1003.4282(6) (c) and is awarded a standard high
 87 school diploma. Such value shall be added to the total full-time
 88 equivalent student membership in basic programs for grades 9
 89 through 12 in the subsequent fiscal year. Each school district
 90 shall allocate the funds received from the bonus FTE funding
 91 under this paragraph to the schools whose students generate the
 92 funds. Funds shall be expended solely for the payment of special
 93 instruction and support services to students eligible for a
 94 certificate of completion who elect to remain in high school for
 95 up to 1 additional year pursuant to s. 1003.4282(6) (c).

96 Section 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 2023.
