State Senator Rosalind Osgood & State Representative Lisa Dunkley to Host Post-Session Town Hall Meeting

SUNRISE, Fla. – **State Senator Rosalind Osgood (D-Tamarac)** and **State Representative Lisa Dunkley (D-Sunrise)** will host a post-session town hall meeting, inviting constituents to discuss and address important issues from the 2023 Florida Legislative Session.
