Legislative Appreciation Award**

**JACKSONVILLE, Fla.** – The **Florida League of Cities**, the united voice for Florida’s municipal governments, recently recognized **State Representative Tracie Davis** with a 2021 Legislative Appreciation Award for her work during the 2021 Legislative Session to protect the Home Rule authority of Florida’s municipalities.



“It’s an honor to be the recipient of the 2021 Legislative Appreciation Award from the Florida League of Cities.
