Language from State Representative Kevin Chambliss' Enterprise Zone Boundaries Bill in CS/CS/SB 912 Passes the Florida House

TALLAHASSEE, Fla. Yesterday, State **Senator Ben Albritton's (R-Bartow)** Commercial Tolling and Extension of Permits and Other Authorization During States of Emergency bill (CS/CS/SB 912), included language of State **Representative Kevin Chambliss' (D-Homestead)** Enterprise Zone Boundaries Bill (HB 285) and passed on the Florida House floor.
