TALLAHASSEE, Fla. – Back in December 2017, 2-year-old **Carnell Williams-Thomas** was struck by a stray bullet and passed away from the injury. The Goulds community was devastated and are reminded of his death every day with the continued violence that occurs. **HB 363** by **Representative Kevin Chambliss (D-Homestead)**, known as Privileged Communications Made to Crime Stoppers Organizations, unanimously passed on the House Floor today in honor of **Carnell Williams-Thomas**. Tomorrow, **Representative Chambliss** will hold a press conference to honor the memory of little Carnell and the impact that **HB 363** will have on communities all over Florida to combat community violence.
