Rep. Smith Urges Hospitals to Issue Remaining First Dose COVID Vaccines to Those 'Extremely Vulnerable' Under 65

Tallahassee, FL - Today, **Representative Carlos Guillermo Smith (D-Orlando)** sent a letter to hospital administrators, urging them to quickly establish public criteria for how people 'extremely vulnerable' to COVID-19 under 65 could be eligible for vaccinations through their networks. Hospitals are currently the only entity currently authorized in Florida to do this according to <u>Governor DeSantis's Executive Order issued December 23rd, 2020.</u>
