Representative Arrington and Senator Jones Introduce Legislation to Create an Animal Abuser Registry

KISSIMMEE, Fla. -Representative Kristen Arrington (D-Kissimmee) introduced <u>HB 1341</u>, an Act to create a statewide Animal Abuser Registry. The companion legislation, <u>SB 1806</u>, was filed by **Senator Shevrin Jones (D-Miami Gardens)**.

"This bill will place restrictions on a convicted animal abuser to own, adopt, live with or work with animals," said **Representative Arrington**. "This registry will help identify these individuals and prevent needless suffering and save the lives of countless animals."
