Representative Hart's Parole Bill Passes Unanimously Out of its Final Committee Stop

TALLAHASSEE, Fla. – On Wednesday, State **Representative Dianne Hart**'s Parole Eligibility bill (HB 169) passed out of the Judiciary Committee. This bill directs the Department of Corrections and the Florida Commission on Offender Review to create clear eligibility requirements for those seeking parole, with no fiscal impact to the state.
